


# EMERGENCY RELIEF FOR TONGA *BENEFIT CONCERT*

On **January 11, 2014**, the island nation of **Tonga** was hit by a **Force 5 Cyclone** named **Ian**, which tore through the most vulnerable center island group of **Ha'apai**. With winds of over 175mph, it destroyed 70-90% of the homes and left their 23 inhabited islands **without food, water, shelter** and access to **medical care**.

### Why Sea Mercy?

Sea Mercy ([www.seamercy.org](http://www.seamercy.org)) is a US based 501(c)3 non-profit organization that serves the often neglected "remote" islands of the South Pacific by providing **free** Floating Health Care Clinics (FHCC). With hundreds of miles often separating their remote islands, Tonga does not have the funds and resources to operate and maintain a FHCC vessel. Sea Mercy and their FHCC vessels carry desperately needed local and international health care volunteers, medicines, food and supplies needed for them.

Sea Mercy has already led non-disaster related operations on Tonga, and at the urgent request of Tonga, is working closely with the national government to deliver the disaster relief to their remote islands. For many of these remote islands, shallow draft catamarans (such as the ones operated by Sea Mercy) are the only vessels capable and experienced enough to perform these emergency relief activities.


